- To promote practice—based education, research and knowledge exchange between the parties.
- To carry out training programs and skill development
- For exchange of support and to avail the facilities of each other for in research and development.
- For performing student enrichment and skill development programs.
- For career guidance and placement programs for the students.
- To share the information between the parties.
- > To co-operate in strengthening higher education.

The MOU is for collaboration between both parties, for mutual benefit and to enhance the quality of educational experience for students.

Both the parties shall take all responsible steps to ensure successful completion of the collaboration and cooperate with each other, duly carrying out the obligation agreed upon.
